FIRST READING: Bob Wall (The Bennett Group, Inc.) Request to rezone property located on Joey Adkins Drive, further identified as ST. Clair County tax ID # 2601110001014000 zoned B-3 (tourist commercial) to be zoned as R-3 (multi-family) and to rezone adjacent property located on Joey Adkins Drive, further identified as ST. Clair County tax ID # 2601110001011000 zoned B-3 (tourist commercial) to also be zoned as R-3 (multi-family).
