8. Wayne Taylor – Consider approval for radiator and fan assembly for Car #326. Total Cost: \$510.32. Parts: O'reilly, Labor: Vulcan. Motion was made by Council Member Matt Morris to approve. Motion was seconded by Council Member Nick Rutledge and all present voted AYE: Motion was carried by unanimous vote.

9. Tim Senft – Consider approval for Sheri Green to attend Magistrate Certification and Training Program in Montgomery. The class is on Fridays from July 6 – August 3. The cost of the class is \$250.00 + related travel expenses. Motion was made by Council Member Lynn Taylor to approve. Motion was seconded by Council Member Linda Crowe and all present voted AYE: Motion was carried by unanimous vote.

10. Steve Mitchell – Consider approval for the Public Works tractor Kubota 8200 to be repaired, vendor Fouts Tractor, cost \$3,839.51, Budgeted item under capital request. Motion was made by Council Member Nick Rutledge to approve. Motion was seconded by Council Member Matt Morris and all present voted AYE: Motion was carried by unanimous vote.

16. Joe Nobles – Consider approval to add safety equipment to the new fire truck, Cost \$4,100.00, paid from 2 mil tax. Motion was made by Council Member Matt Morris to approve. Motion was seconded by Council Member Lynn Taylor and all present voted AYE: Motion was carried by unanimous vote.
